RESURGO FAQs

Is there a cap on race entries?

Yes! We have the marathon capped at 150 runners, and the half marathon capped at 100 runners currently. If we get high volunteer numbers, we may increase these as we get closer to the date, but it's best to register early to avoid disappointment.

Are strollers or dogs allowed in the event?

Unfortunately no strollers or dogs are allowed at Resurgo this year due to insurance reasons.

Am I able to cancel my registration and receive a refund?

No; however, you can transfer your registration to another person who hasn't registered yet! This can be completed through Race Roster.

Am I allowed to walk the event?

Yes, however please be aware that the course closes at 2pm and the finish line will be taken away by then.

Is the route closed to traffic?

The route takes place entirely on the waterfront trails, so you will not have to worry about vehicles! However the trails will be open to other trail users during the event, so please be courteous when passing walkers.

Can I volunteer for this event?

Are there water stops along the course?

Water stops will be available along the course every 5 to 6 kilometres.

Where do I pick up my bib?

Bib pick up will be at the Chocolate River Station on September 7th.

Where can I park my car?

The Fundy Chocolate River Station has some parking available, but there is also parking available on the side streets opposite the start/finish line in Riverview.

During the race, is there a secure location I can leave my personal belongings?

We are working to have a bag check at the Chocolate River Station for race participants; bags can be dropped off the morning of the event. Please be advised that we are not responsible for any lost or damaged items that are left in bag check.

Will washrooms be provided on route?

Yes! There are bathrooms at the Chocolate River Station at the start/finish, as well as pit toilets at various points along the marathon route.
